



Gaga pit kit: approval pack

A compact, engineered bracket kit for organisations planning a supervised gaga play space. Each kit provides eight galvanised steel corner brackets, galvanised bolts and hardware, printed build instructions and a timber shopping list. The brackets are Australian-made, designed, engineered and made in Victoria by the founder, a father and school teacher. Timber is sourced locally by the buyer.

WHAT'S INCLUDED / NOT INCLUDED

Included in either kit

- 8 galvanised steel corner brackets
- Galvanised bolts and hardware
- Printed build instructions
- Timber shopping list

Not included

Timber sleepers, ground surfacing, tools, installation labour and a ball. The buyer selects and prepares the site and arranges local timber and any labour needed.

THE TWO KITS

80 cm kit - \$549

4 sleepers high. Uses 32 x 200 x 75 mm x 2.4 m H4 treated pine sleepers. Suits organisations planning a taller wall.

60 cm kit - \$499

3 sleepers high. Uses 24 x 200 x 75 mm x 2.4 m H4 treated pine sleepers. Suits organisations planning a lower wall.

DIMENSIONS AND SPACE NEEDED

Standard pit

Regular octagon with 8 sides of 2.4 m, approximately 5.8 m across. There is no permanent foundation: assess and prepare the chosen site for the installation.

Planning allowance

Allow approximately 1.5 m of clear space around the pit. A useful overall planning allowance is about 9 m x 9 m, including movement and supervision space.

TIMBER NEEDED

80 cm

32 x 2.4 m H4 treated pine sleepers, 200 x 75 mm.

60 cm

24 x 2.4 m H4 treated pine sleepers, 200 x 75 mm.

BUILD OVERVIEW

Assembly

Allow most of a day for two people. Use basic tools, follow the printed instructions and allow time for setting out, cutting, drilling, bolting and final checks.

Site and supervision checklist

Level site; 1.5 m clearance; grass, mulch, compacted gravel or synthetic grass assessed for suitability; check edges and fixings before use; supervise to school policy; inspect fixings and timber periodically.
